Narraweena Public School Mobile Device Policy

(including Mobile Phones and smart watches)

MOBILE DEVICES (INCLUDING MOBILE PHONES AND SMART WATCHES)

From time to time students bring mobile devices to school. The school requests that students come to the school office if they need to contact parents during the day. Parents who wish to contact their child should do so through the school office on 9971 5778.

The following guidelines apply if a student brings mobile devices to school:

- Mobile devices must remain in the child's school bag while on the school grounds and during the school day, or it may be logged in at the office. Mobile devices are brought to school at the owner's risk. The school will not accept any responsibility for loss, theft or damage to a mobile device. We encourage these mobile devices to stay at home during the school week.
- Mobile devices may not be used in a way which is likely to disrupt the learning environment or interfere with the operation of the school. They may not be used in any way which threatens the wellbeing and safety of another student. Such activities may incur disciplinary action including confiscation and even suspension.
- Mobile devices at school should only be used for reasons relating to student safety in travelling to and from school.
