Election Day BBQ – 21st May

Colour Run –30th June (Confirmed)

The colour run was launched on 2 June and as at 11:30am today we have already raised \$23,441! 30% of this covers the cost of the prizes and the rest goes to the school.

There are various prizes throughout the month in the lead up such as:

- Class in each stage with the most profiles wins (awarded on 10 June)

- Highest fundraising class on the day gets a pizza party lunch & the teacher gets a free canteen lunch
